## Code of Conduct

The community of Harborne Academy will ensure that everyone has the right to work in a safe and pleasant environment. There is an expectation that ALL students will:

- Treat others as you would wish others to treat you respect adults and young people alike
- Be truthful at all times
- Be polite to all adults and visitors to the Academy and in the community
- Dress smartly in the correct uniform
- Look after the environment in school and in the community.

This means that in the school community, ALL learners will:

- A. During Lessons And Formal Learning Time
- Be fully equipped to learn
- Listen and follow instructions provided by adults responsible for their learning
- Focus on the set task
- Work to the best of their ability
- Ask for help when needed.
- B. During Assemblies and Pastoral Time
- Enter the hall in silence
- Listen and follow instructions provided by adults responsible for their learning.
- C. Whilst in the Dining Room
- Line up sensibly, following the termly rota
- Co-operate and say thank you to staff in the Dining Area
- Eat food quietly and with good table manners
- Clear food/plates away. Keep learning areas tidy.

#### D. Whilst Outside

- Refrain from bullying, swearing or name calling
- No fighting or threatening violent behaviour
- Include all others who wish to participate
- Avoid rough or dangerous games or activities.

#### E. During Social Time

- Respect all others and refrain from teasing or name calling
- No bullying, fighting or swearing
- Move around the building and in open spaces in a calm, caring and safe manner
- To refrain from using mobile phones during Academy hours.

#### ICT use policy for Students:

Using The School's Computers & Internet you agree to the following:

- Don't tell anyone your username or password.
- (Or allow others to access the network using your username).
- Only visit sites which are appropriate to my work at the time.
- Do not use Chat Rooms or Social Networking Sites.
- It is not permitted to bypass any network/Internet security or filtering systems.
- Treat the academy's computers with respect.

#### Students Must Also Agree To The Following:

- Never get involved in cyberbullying.
- Make sure all the messages; emails that I send are respectful and sensible.
- Show or tell a responsible adult straight away if:
- I receive a harmful message or email.
- I get sent anything that makes me feel uncomfortable.
- Always keep my personal details private, and those of any person at Harborne Academy (e.g. Phone Number, address or email address)
- Never to deliberately browse, download, upload, forward or material that could be considered offensive or illegal.

Always check with a responsible adult and my parents before I show photographs of myself.

I will ensure that my online activity, both in school and outside school, will not cause anyone at my school distress or harm.

I understand that all my use of the internet and other technologies can be monitored and logged.

### <u>Failure to comply with our acceptable use policy will result in one or more of the following</u>

- A ban, temporary or permanent in the use of the school's Internet and computer facilities.
- Parents being informed after a breach of the policy.
- Appropriate sanctions and action being taken by the Head of Year.
- Any other action which is decided by the Head teacher and governors of Harborne Academy
