'Set Aside':
Contingency to support one-off payments to minimise barriers to learning e.g. internet access, revision aids, lesson materials, dictionaries.
Access 'higher' art or cultural experiences
Provide resources for the development of a programme of extra-curricular music, drama, dance and sport
